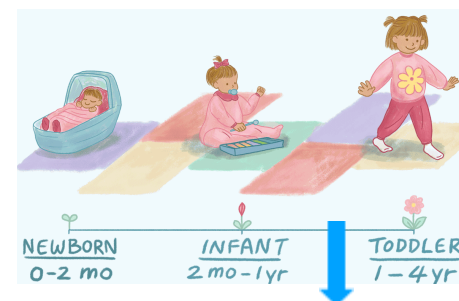
We all enjoy doing different things!



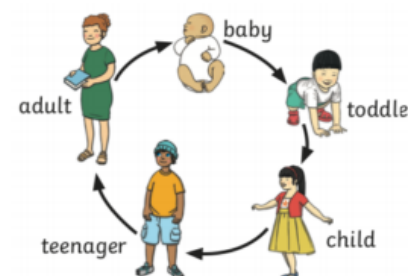
Taking care of your body helps it to grow. Food, exercise, water and plenty of sleep helps your body grow.
