Multiplication and division

Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.

Fractions

Recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Geometry

Position and direction

Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

Measurement

Time and money

Recognise and count coins and notes.

Read and compare time to the hour and half an hour.
