Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that St Peter's Primary School will be welcoming **the Breck Foundation**, a nationally recognised online safety charity, to deliver workshops to mark Safer Internet Day (10th February) for our pupils in Years 3–6, as well as an online parent and carer information session.

Who are the Breck Foundation?

The Breck Foundation is a Southeast England-based charity with national impact, founded in 2014 following the tragic death of Breck Bednar, a 14-year-old boy who was groomed and murdered by someone he met online.

The Foundation's mission is to prevent this from ever happening again by educating children, young people, parents, and professionals about online grooming, exploitation, and online safety.

Each year, the Breck Foundation reaches thousands of children in schools across the UK, filling an important gap in the current curriculum and helping young people stay safe online.

What will your child learn?

The Breck Foundation delivers age-appropriate, engaging online safety sessions for primary schools, designed to be accessible and supportive. ***Please see the attached pdf for more information regarding content.***

Parent & Carer Online Safety Session

There has been an 89% increase in online grooming crimes in the last six years (NSPCC, 2024), and more than 300 million children worldwide are victims of online sexual exploitation and abuse each year (Childlight, 2024).

Research shows that 9 out of 10 young people say they would act differently online after a Breck Foundation workshop.

The parent session will help you understand:

- What your children have been taught in school
- Who online groomers are and the different types of grooming
- How to have open, trusting conversations about online safety
- Where and how to get help if your child is at risk
- Breck's story and a screening of Breck's Last Game

These sessions are a valuable opportunity to strengthen communication at home and support your child's wellbeing and safety online.
