Addition and subtraction with four digit numbers

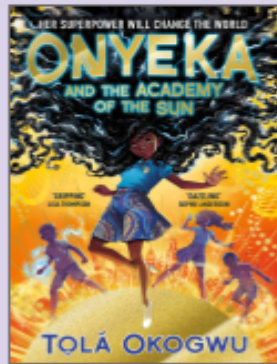
Place Value up to 1000

Geography

Topic: Geography of Egypt

The children will learn to : locate Egypt on a map, identify its key geographical features (including rivers, deserts and seas) and describe the climate and compare it to the UK.

SCIENCE: Electricity

The children will:

- identify different circuit components and explain what they do.
- build series circuits, identifying and explaining whether they are complete or incomplete.
- explain what electrical conductors and insulators are and give several examples of these.
- identify several different switches and explain how switches work in a circuit.
- apply their knowledge of electricity to different situations

COMPUTING

The children will use Purple Mash to learn: Coding and Online Safety

ENGLISH

Talk for Writing: Non-Chronological Report and 'Rags to Riches' Tale

Reading: We will develop the children's vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval, summary skills through daily Reading lessons.
