Topic: How Did the Tudor Era Change Life in England?

We will learn about King Henry VII, Henry VIII, and Elizabeth I.

Retell the story of the Battle of Bosworth and explain why it was a turning point in British history

Understand key events leading to Tudor reign and explain the formation of the Tudor Rose.

Talk about crime and punishment in Tudor society and explain differences between Tudor and modern punishments.

Recognize differences in life between rich and poor Tudors through identifying Tudor housing, clothing and food.

ENGLISH

Talk for Writing: Discussion texts and Portal Tales
