Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 4 February, Year 4 will be visiting the British Museum to look at Ancient Egyptian artefacts as part of our history learning.

Please note, there is no cost for this trip.

We will be travelling by train and there will be plenty of walking involved. We will be leaving at 9:00am and as we are taking public transport to the museum, we expect to return to school later than normal pick up, between approximately 3:30 -3:45pm. Please wait outside the main school entrance to collect your child. In the event of late return, a text message will be sent out by the office.

Children will need to bring a water bottle (no fizzy drinks or glass), preferably in a small rucksack. They will also need a coat in case of bad weather. Your child will be entitled to a free school packed lunch, which will be provided by the school. But you are also welcome to provide them with a packed lunch yourself.
