Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 2 – Trip to Rottingdean Beach

We are very excited about our upcoming trip to Rottingdean Beach on Friday 12 June 2026. Just a reminder that we will be travelling by coach and will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am and aim to return by 3.30pm. The office will inform you if we are running late.

Children will need to bring a small labelled rucksack containing:

- a packed lunch (provided by the school or from home) with a drink (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or nuts)
- a refillable water bottle
- a sun hat
- a raincoat

We are asking for a contribution of £15.85 to be paid on www.parentpay.com by 11 May. This trip will also be supported by the St Peter's School Association (SPSA). By paying for the trip, you are giving consent for your child to participate and travel there and back by coach. If we do not receive sufficient donations, we may have to cancel the trip.

Your child will be entitled to a free school packed lunch, which will be provided by the school. But you are also welcome to provide them with a packed lunch yourself. Please indicate on this google form which of these options you would prefer: <https://forms.gle/Xz4QeGUCpaeyvNR26>

We are looking for a limited number of volunteers for this trip, so if you are available on this date, indicate this on the form and your class teacher will contact you.

During the trip, they will also be able to have an ice lolly /ice-cream to enjoy on the beach. Please indicate their choice (Calippo- orange/cola, twister, mini milk, vegan) on the form.

The children will be allowed to wear their own clothes for the visit but we ask that they wear trainers and **NOT** sandals/flip flops. We will hand out hi-vis jackets for all the children to wear over their clothes to make them easier to identify. The children will **NOT** be allowed to go in the sea or swim at any point. There is no need to bring any spending money as all costs are already covered by the SPSA.

Please apply sunscreen before the children arrive at school as staff will not be able to apply this for them. If your child suffers from travel sickness please give them any medication they require before arriving.
