Dear Parents and Carers,

Class R visit to [Gatton Park, Reigate](#)

As part of our learning, we have arranged a visit to Gatton Park on **Wednesday 10 June 2026**. The visit will take place entirely within the school day and we will be travelling by coach. We will be leaving at 9.00 am and we will return in time for the end of school. Everyone will need to order a school packed lunch or bring a packed lunch from home (lots of water and no fizzy drinks, cans, glass bottles, nuts, sweets or chocolate!!!).

We need to ask you to make a contribution of **£13.00** towards the cost of this trip, which will also be supported by the St Peter's School Association (SPSA). Please pay this on www.parentpay.com by **Monday 18 May**. By paying for the trip, you are giving consent for your child to participate and travel there and back by coach. If we do not receive sufficient donations, we may have to cancel the trip.

The children can wear their own clothes so no school uniform. Gatton Park suggest the following: Wear layers of clothes and bring a fleece or jumper to keep you warm if the weather changes. Wear trousers to protect your legs from scratches and nettle stings. Wear suitable shoes for walking around at Gatton Park, e.g. trainers. You will also need to bring Wellingtons, boots or old trainers if it is wet and muddy (the children can wear their Wellington boots currently at school if you prefer). Wear or bring a waterproof coat or jacket. Don't wear your best clothes as they may get dirty! Please apply sun cream in the morning if it's a sunny day and remember a named sun hat if it's sunny. Your child does not need spending money.

If any parents would like help on the day, please let us know, however, we only have a few spaces.

As stated above your child will be entitled to a free school packed lunch but you are also welcome to provide them with a packed lunch yourself. Please indicate on the google form which of these options you would prefer by **Monday 18 May**: <https://forms.gle/hbcq3VT62Fv8JF7e6>.
