Dear Parents/Carers,

CYM TRIP – 15th to 18th June 2026

I am writing to clarify final arrangements for the trip to CYM.

Departure Time: The children should arrive at school at between 7.45-8.00am for a prompt departure time of 8.30am (the children will walk to Bankside from the school as this is where the coach will be waiting). All children should go to the main hall where they will be met by a member of staff.

Each child will need to bring a packed lunch with them for their lunch on Monday 15th

We expect the group to arrive back at St. Peter's by 2.00/2.30pm on Thursday 18th June. Please ensure that you are at the school on time to pick your child up on the Thursday – it can be very upsetting for a child if parents are late picking them up. If there are any changes to that time, we will keep you updated by text or email. If your child normally attends Afterschool Club on Thursday you will need to cancel this if it is not required. If you cannot be at the school until the normal end of day to collect your child, please let us know before the trip.

Members of Staff: Miss Gould (trip leader), Mrs Patel, Mrs Penston (first aider), Mrs Barriball and Miss Hingert will accompany Year 6 for the whole week.

Pocket Money: see information on the kit list.

Valuables: No items of value should be taken on the trip and anything taken that is of value is taken at your own risk. *****No mobile phones or electronic games are to be taken in any circumstances.*****

Clothing and belongings: All items should be clearly marked with your child's name. Don't forget to mark cameras and their cases.

Medicines: If you have informed us that your child is required to take any medicines during the residential (including travel pills) please place these in a suitable container that is **clearly marked with your child's name, medical complaint and clear dosage instructions.** Please make sure that there are enough tablets to last for five days. Medicines should be handed to your Mrs Penston on the morning of departure. Unless we hear otherwise, we shall assume it is safe to administer treatment to your child for minor ailments like coughs, colds and headaches (but we will contact you to check this in the first instance regardless). In other words, if he/she is allergic to certain medicines or there could possibly be a reaction, because of the medicines already being taken, please notify us accordingly.

If you have noted on the medical form that your child may need an asthma pump or hay fever medication, can you please ensure that you bring these medicines in on the day of travel. Your child should not have any medication with them unless we have been notified of this via the google form sent out. If there are any changes to this information, please email the office urgently (admin@st-petersprimary.co.uk).

Contact during the trip: The children will be very busy throughout the week both during the day and evening, and it is essential for the harmony of the whole party that any contact, if this is deemed necessary, is made through the school, on 020 8688 5414. Mr Sonnar will be the home school contact for the week. The staff will have all parental emergency contact details with them if they need to contact you for any reason.
