Dear Parents and Carers,

Hot Weather – Measures in Place

With the recent rise in temperatures, I am writing to let you know about the steps we are taking to keep your children safe, comfortable, and well during the hot weather.

The safety and wellbeing of all our pupils is our top priority, and staff will continue to monitor the weather and adjust arrangements as needed throughout the day.

During the hottest part of the day, we will be making the following adjustments:

- Children in Years 5 & 6 will be in the hall rather than outside, to keep them out of the sun during the warmest period.
- Younger children will remain inside or in shaded areas for the majority of break and lunchtimes.
- Outdoor PE and sports activities will be reduced, moved indoors, or rescheduled where possible.
- Children will be encouraged to play in shaded areas of the playground when they are outside.
- Classrooms will be well ventilated, with windows and doors opened where possible to encourage a through draught.
- Blinds will be kept closed and lights switched off where appropriate to reduce the temperature in classrooms.

How you can help us at home:

- Please apply sun cream to your child before school, as staff are not able to apply this for them.
- A named sun hat is recommended and can be worn throughout the school day.
- Please send your child in with a named, filled water bottle, which can be topped up during the day.
- Lighter, loose-fitting clothing in line with our uniform policy is welcomed during this period.

Staff will continue to keep a close eye on all children for any signs of heat exhaustion, and we will contact you directly should we have any concerns about your child.

Thank you, as always, for your support in helping us keep the children safe and comfortable during this warm spell.
