If your financial circumstances have changed and you think your child(ren) may be entitled to free school meals click on the following link to check your eligibility. If you need assistance with this, please contact the school office.

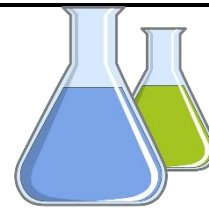
