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OUR CAMPS (Holiday Camps)

We have formed a partnership with Our Camps, who will be running camps at St Peter's throughout the school holidays. Their first one will be running from 20th-23rd December. They offer a wide range of activities (which may include: skateboarding, photography, street dance, arts and crafts, sports and games, drama and many others). Prices start at £25.00 per day. A hot lunch can be provided at a cost of £5 per child, but your child can also bring a packed lunch if you prefer. Parking
