Respecting the School Grounds

- **Please do not let your child climb up on the bank at the front of the school. They could slip and fall onto the concrete path below and sustain a nasty injury. Furthermore, it is an area which has grass and some wildflowers which will be destroyed if they are trampled on. If you see your child making a move to climb, please stop them before we have to.**
- **NO scootering or cycling anywhere within the school grounds please.**
- **NO dogs on the school site at any time of the day (this includes drop off at breakfast club or pick up from afterschool club)**
- **Please remember to park safely and considerately when you drop off or collect your children. Be patient and pay attention to children or parents crossing the road.**

Remember

- To keep your distance from the school staff at the start and end of the day.
- The rules on social distancing at all times.
- Please leave the school premises promptly after pick up and drop off.
- Where possible, only one adult should pick up and drop children off.
